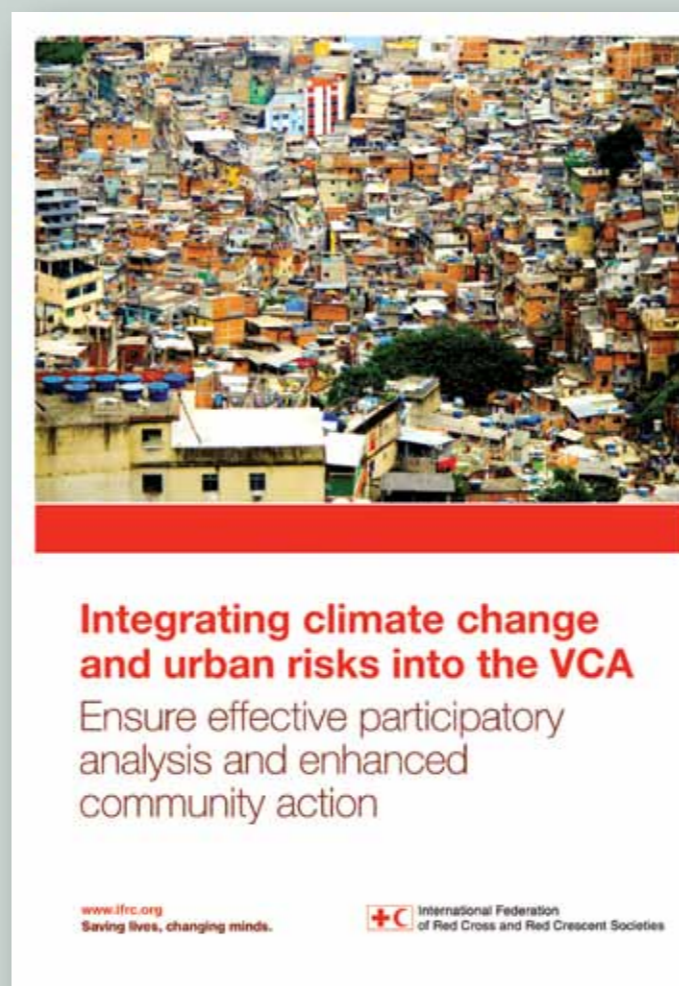
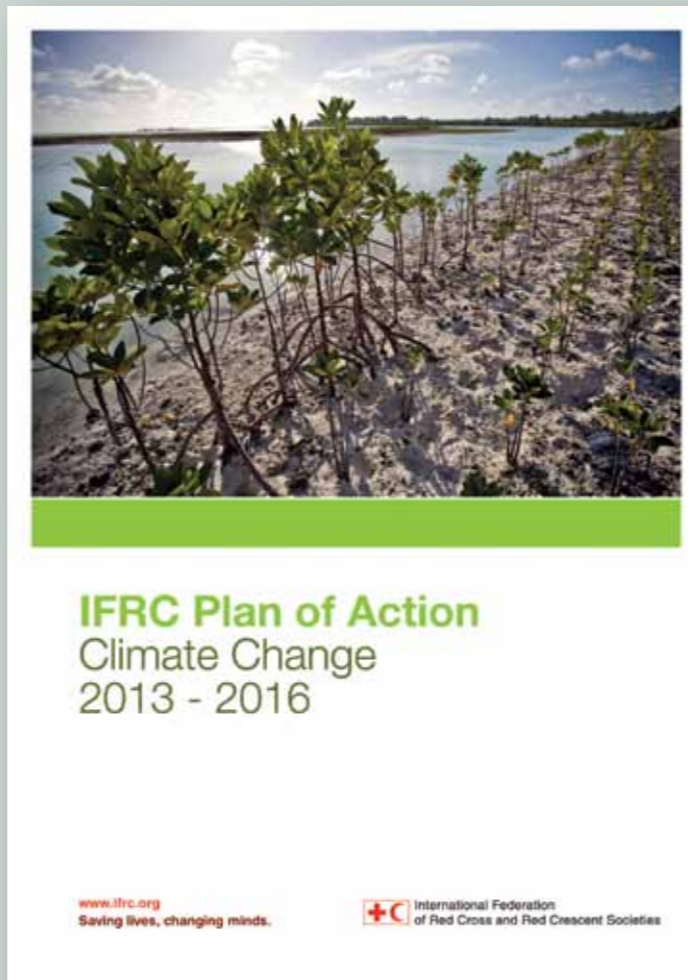


# Building Resilience in a Changing Climate

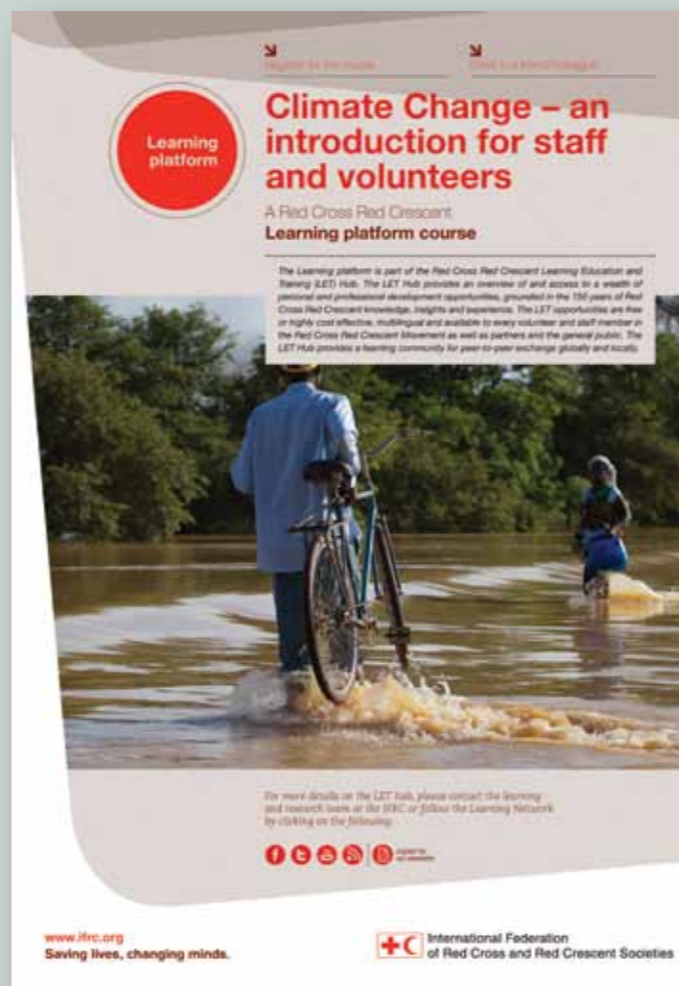


## Integrating climate change and urban risks in to the VCA- Ensure effective participatory analysis and enhanced community action:

## Red Cross Red Crescent Learning platform course

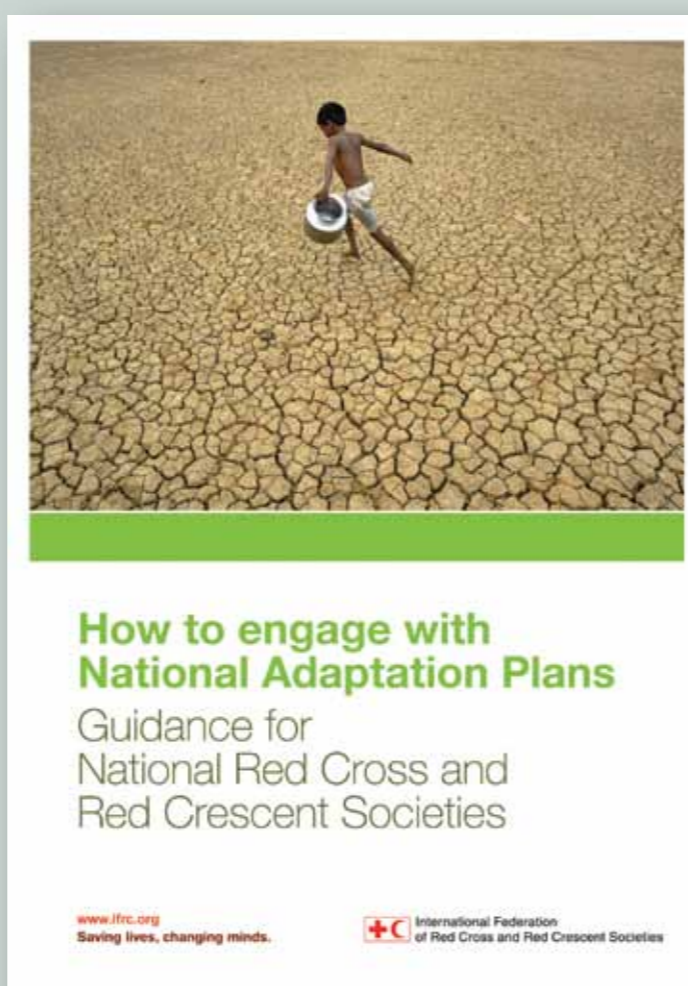
### 'Climate Change - an introduction for staff and volunteers':

With this course, Red Cross Red Crescent staff and volunteers with no or little knowledge of climate change issues can learn about the root causes and the consequences of climate change and find out how to help address these issues in their day to day work within local communities.

The course is designed for smartphones, tablets and desktops and lasts approximately 30 minutes.

## How to engage with National Adaptation Plans- Guidance for National Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies:

This document highlights the importance and the need for bringing the voices of most vulnerable in to the national policy dialogue and national adaptation planning (NAP) process.
